Funding Criteria

REQUEST PROCESS

Any Member or Friend of First Parish, including youth, may submit a request. Please use the LMCF form on the website or from the First Parish office. Interested persons are encouraged to direct initial questions to a member of the LMCF committee.

ELIGIBLE ACTIVITIES/RESTRICTIONS

- Guided by the First Parish mission and Unitarian Universalist principles, funds will be used to support social action that involves First Parish Members and Friends.
- LMCF will NOT be used for "checkbook activism" (i.e. donations will not be redistributed to other organizations), NOR for partisan activities (i.e. support for a political candidate or party).
- Funds are for new activities not currently funded by the church (although funds could be used to expand an existing program).
- Funds may be used to cover additional staff hours to manage and promote social action.

FUNDING PREFERENCE WILL BE GIVEN TO ACTIVITIES THAT:

- Provide impact in support of the Unitarian Universalist principles
- Are open to the entire First Parish congregation
- Are open to members of the greater Wayland community
- Are open to other area UU congregations and/or neighboring religious groups
- Are locally based (within driving range)
- Would lead to continued action over time (not a "one off" project)

FIRST PARISH MISSION:

To Build Community by forging caring connections and supporting one another through the joys, sorrows and mysteries of life.

To Search for Meaning by creating opportunities for all ages to explore values and principles that orient and guide us through life.

To Deepen Our Spirituality by gathering to share words and music, by nurturing private moments of reflection, and by cultivating reverence.

To Make a Better World by engaging in compassionate service and promoting social justice.

- Justice, equity and compassion in human relations
- Acceptance of one another and encouragement to spiritual growth in our congregations
- A free and responsible search for truth and meaning

- Respect for the interdependent web of all existence of which we are a part
